INSPECTION OF LANDING/TAXI LIGHT SUPPLY CABLE ROUTING

Part 1: At or before next 50 hour inspection (once only inspection)

Part 2: At or before next 50 hour inspection

PART 1: INSPECTION:

APPLICABILITY:

All T67A, T67B, T67C, T67M (not including Works No. 1999) and T67M-MkII.

**INTRODUCTION:** 

An incident has occurred whereby the landing/taxi light supply wire has chafed against the battery terminal.

**ACTION:** 

Inspect routing of the landing/taxi light supply wire and ensure adequate clearance exists between the supply wire and the battery +ve terminal. Allowance should be made for cable movement during all possible flight envelope manoeuvres.

Adjust and tie off the supply wire routing, if required.

PART 2: FITMENT OF BATTERY POSITIVE TERMINAL BOOT:

APPLICABILITY:

All T67C, T67M (not including Works No. 1999) and T67M-Mkll.

**ACTION:** 

Fit boot, Part No. MS25171-3S (126-31-173) to battery positive terminal wire.

Annotate Log Book "Mod M651 incorporated".

NB: A battery terminal boot is not available for T67A and T67B aircraft.
